RPC finalists in innovation and sustainability awards

RPC bpi protec's and RPC M&H Plastics were finalists in the biennial EPRO (European Association of Plastics Recycling and Recovery Operations) Awards celebrated at the Identiplast gala dinner in March 2019. Entering both the Innovation and Sustainability Awards respectively the RPC products were amongst the final four finalists in their categories.

Garçon Wines' innovative rPET Flat Wine Bottle from RPC M&H Plastics offers its customers the unbeatable sustainable opportunity to slash carbon emissions and business costs from the wine supply chain. Made using 100% post-consumer recycled PET plastic, and fully recyclable after use, the bottles conform to traditional wine bottle shapes but are 40% more spatially efficient and 87% lighter than round, glass bottles of the same volume,

meaning they require less space and energy along the supply chain. Importantly, the bottles respect the rich heritage of the wine industry and look beautiful on a dining table.
